Disclosure of Convictions or Complaints since Last Disclosure

In order to provide as much protection as we can to the public and to protect the integrity and accountability of DAPAANZ as a professional association, applicants for renewal of registration of practitioner competency will be required to disclose any offences committed for which they have been convicted in a court of law and that carries a minimum 1 year sentence; and any complaints against their practice which have been upheld.

Disclosure is common practice with membership of professional organisations. Disclosure is not required for membership of DAPAANZ but it is to be registered as a competent practitioner.
